



OUTSTANDING TEEN Competition & Entry Information

The fourth annual Miss Lake of the Ozarks Outstanding Teen pageant will be held in conjunction with the Miss pageant on October 30, 2010 at School of the Osage Auditorium, 646 Hwy 42, Osage Beach, MO 65065. The pageant is an open program for any eligible contestants from within the State of Missouri. Rehearsal will be held Friday, October 29th from 6:00-10:00 p.m. You need a metallic color top, denim jeans and black heels for opening number which is to Top of the World by Pussycat Dolls. The top can be silver, gold, bronze, pewter, etc. as long as it has sparkle. Interviews will be Saturday afternoon and the show will begin at 7:00 p.m. We would be honored to have you as a contestant.

Eligibility

- Be at least 13 years of age by day of the local pageant. She can be no older than 17 years of age as of July 31, 2011. She cannot be eligible to compete in the Miss Missouri level at any time during that pageant year.
- Be no more than a rising senior by the time of the national competition (August 2011).
- Be and have always been a female.
- Be a United States citizen.
- Have been a resident in the state in which she is competing for at least 6 months prior to the local or state competition.
- Must reside in, be enrolled in, and attending classes on a full-time basis at an accredited public, private, or home-schooling program, in the state which she intends to represent in the state or national finals.
- Be single, never married, nor have been the parent of any natural or adopted child.
- Never been convicted of a crime, does not have any criminal charges pending against her, and be of good moral character.
- Be in reasonable good health (to the best of her knowledge) and able to participate fully and without limitation in any activity program in the competition.
- Not use or consume alcohol or any illegal, controlled, or dangerous substances.
- Be able to meet the time commitment and job responsibilities as set forth by Miss Missouri's Outstanding Teen and Miss Missouri.
- Be judged in all phases of competition, which includes Talent, Interview, Lifestyle and Fitness in Sportswear, Scholastic Achievement, and On-stage Question.
- Agree that all decisions of the judges are final and binding.

Competitions & Scoring

TALENT (35%)

- Contestant's talent must be no longer than two minutes. Contestants should e-mail their music as an mp3 and bring one copy on CD to rehearsal as a backup. If you are unable to e-mail the mp3 please snail mail two CDs with your paperwork. The competition music should be the only song recorded on the CD. Please label the CD(s) with your name, type of talent and song selection. No cassette tapes will be allowed.
- "Live" accompaniment is not permitted. Only the contestant is permitted on stage. No other person may be a part of her presentation though background vocals will be allowed as long as they don't overpower the contestant.
- Talent must be performed live; pantomime or lip-sync are not permitted.
- Tap dancers may not have accompaniment CDs with pre-recorded taps or tap sounds.
- The sound engineer will not stop and re-start an accompaniment CD as a part of the Contestant's performance. If the Contestant needs a ten second delay in her performance, then the CD should include a ten second silent spot.
- Fire (fire ropes, fire batons, etc.), pyrotechnics, swords, knives or machetes, bow and arrow acts, and the use of live animals are strictly prohibited.
- A talent introduction will be written by the producer.

INTERVIEW (35%)

- Interviews will be a total of six minutes. The contestant will be introduced. There will be no opening or closing remarks.
- Questions will come from a variety of areas, including, but not limited to, the contestant's application and fact sheet, moral/ethical issues, current events, etc. Contestants should be prepared to answer any type of question asked.
- Contestant's wardrobe should be age appropriate.

EVENING WEAR (15%)

- Contestant should wear age appropriate attire that makes her feel beautiful and special.
- Age appropriate full-length gowns or full-length pantsuits are appropriate. Shorter attire may be worn, but must be age appropriate and non-revealing when worn on stage.

LIFESTYLE & FITNESS (10%)

- Contestant may select a one or two-piece outfit that she would feel comfortable wearing to work out or exercise in. Modesty and decency should be appropriate guidelines when selecting attire.
- Hose may not be used. Oil may not be used. Excessive lotion may not be used.
- Contestants will wear tennis shoes or other aerobic footwear during the active wear competition.

ON-STAGE QUESTION (5%)

- On-Stage Question(s) will be asked.

TOP FIVE RANKING

- The five contestants with the most points will be ranked by the judge's panel in the order they believe each should finish in the competition. A contestant receiving the first placement on a judge's score sheet will receive ten points, the second will receive five points, the third will receive three points, the fourth will receive two points and the fifth will receive one point. The contestants with the most points will be awarded the title.
- The outcome of the pageant is based solely on the scores from the final ballot. These points will NOT be added to the scores from the previous competitions.

Other Information

- Please submit a photograph (preferably a B&W head shot) to be used in the program book. This photograph will be returned the day of the pageant. Can also e-mail a jpeg file to: taraosseck@hotmail.com.
- The judge's panel will consist of five people from a variety of backgrounds and experience. The panel will be compiled pursuant to Miss Missouri guidelines.
- Contestant order will be determined by the order complete packets are received.
- Opening Production details/outfits will be determined by September 1st.
- Contestants must do their own hair and make-up. Parents, make-up artists, hair stylists, etc., will not be allowed backstage or in the dressing areas.
- Hostesses will be available to assist contestants backstage or in the dressing areas. Parents, families, friends or pageant coaches are not allowed backstage or in the dressing areas.
- The schedule for the day of the pageant will be finalized later. Upon receipt of a complete packet, additional information will be e-mailed regarding the day's schedule.
- Ticket prices for the program will be \$8/Adult, \$4/12 & under (under 3 free).

Entry Information

FEE & AWARDS PACKAGE

- There is a \$100 entry fee to enter the Miss Lake of the Ozarks Outstanding Teen Pageant.
- Deadline to submit the required paperwork is October 20, 2010.
- The minimum awards package for the titleholder will include a Miss America Outstanding Teen local preliminary crown, payment of the \$150 entry fee to next summer's Miss Missouri's Outstanding Teen Pageant; and a \$50 savings bond. Additional awards may be added prior to October 30, 2010.

Responsibilities of Miss Lake of the Ozarks Outstanding Teen

This Miss Lake of the Ozarks Outstanding Teen director and committee will assist the 2011 titleholder with preparation for Miss Missouri's Outstanding Teen. This will include Mock Interviews, Wardrobe Review, and Talent Review. It is our hope to be able to schedule community activities for our 2011 Outstanding Teen. The 2011 Miss Lake of the Ozarks Outstanding Teen must attend a mandatory Miss Missouri Orientation in March (tentatively March 27, 2011) to be held in Mexico, MO. Miss Missouri's Outstanding Teen Pageant will be held in Mexico, MO, Tentatively June 8 – 11, 2011. Contestants will be required to report to Mexico earlier in the week, details will be provided at the MMOT Orientation Meeting in March 2011. The winner of the Miss Missouri's Outstanding Teen Pageant will represent the state at Miss America's Outstanding Teen Pageant, tentatively scheduled for August 2011, in Orlando, FL.
