



Young Miss Lake of the Ozarks Pageant
March 3, 2012 at 1:00 p.m.

The 3rd annual Tiny, Little, Young & Pre-Teen Miss Lake of the Ozarks pageant will be held at the School of the Osage Upper Elementary (626 Hwy 42, Osage Beach, MO 65065). Rehearsal will be held from 10:00am-12:00pm and the pageant will begin promptly at 1:00 p.m. To reduce the number of outfit changes needed, contestants will wear their Casual Wear for opening number and Party Wear for On-Stage Question & closing number. Contestants will have plenty of time to change for talent. Overall winners in each division will receive flowers, a crown, and a sash. If there are a minimum of five contestants in any age division the first runner-up will be crowned Tiny/Little/Young/Pre-Teen Miss Sweetheart. Winners (Overall & Sweetheart) will be invited to ride in parades with Miss Lake of the Ozarks, make an appearance at the 2012 Miss Lake of the Ozarks Pageant in October (date TBA) and compete in the 2012 state pageant in Mexico, Missouri. Trophies will be given to photogenic winner(s) from each division. We would be honored to have you as a contestant.

Four Age Divisions (Overall & Sweetheart)

Tiny Miss.....3-5 years
Little Miss.....6-8 years

Young Miss.....9-11 years
Pre-Teen Miss.....12-14 years

ONE (1) PHOTO NEEDED: Each contestant is required to turn in one picture with her application. E-mail a head & shoulder photo to kile.ashley@gmail.com or include a picture with your application packet. Due date for the program book is February 11th. School pictures are acceptable. (The photo may be resized to fit program requirements.)

Ticket Information

Tickets will be on sale at the door on the day of the pageant for \$5.00 per person. Children 2 years old and under are free. Everyone occupying a seat must have a ticket.

AREAS OF COMPETITION

On-Stage Interview (25%), Casual Wear (25%), Party Wear (25%), Talent (25%)

On-Stage Interview

Contestants will be asked two age-appropriate questions on stage. This will count for 25% of the overall score. Contestants will wear their party wear out fit.

Casual Wear

Contestants should wear clothing that is appropriate for school or an evening out. It should reflect the contestants' personality and style. This phase of competition counts for 25% of the total score.

Party Wear

Contestants should wear clothing that they would wear to a party or formal/semi-formal event. It should reflect the contestants' personality and style. This phase of competition counts for 25% of the total score.

Talent

Talent is considered to be anything that requires poise and ability in front of an audience. Talent presentation must be live and cannot exceed 2 minutes. Props are allowed if they are used in the performance. Nonfunctional props tend to distract from the contestant. Fire batons, knife twirling, or any talent that would constitute danger to anyone in close proximity will not be permitted. If you dance sing, or play an instrument, you are responsible for your own accompaniment CD. Please mark your name and age division on your CD.

CDs must contain ONLY your competition song. The sound technician will not accept CDs with more than one song. Talent that exceeds the 2 minute limit will be cut off at 2 minutes, even though the performance may not be completed. Please bring a backup CD, in case of technical difficulty.

A variety of talent may be used as competition such as dramatic readings, speeches, art work, piano, vocal, dance, instrumental solos, reciting poems, etc. A one or two line poem or nursery rhyme is considered an appropriate talent in the Tiny Miss division. Contestants may not duplicate talent submissions within a division. In the case of a duplicate talent, the first to turn in the application will be accepted. Contestants will be notified immediately if there is a duplication of talent, in order to pick a new talent.

OPTIONAL PHOTOGENIC & PEOPLE'S CHOICE CONTESTS

There will be an OPTIONAL photogenic contest with an additional \$10 entry fee per photo entered. Contestants may submit photos to be judged and a PHOTOGENIC WINNER will be announced from each age division. Photos should not be larger than 8 X 10. If a contestant wishes to be entered into the photogenic contest, they should include the photogenic entry form and submit the photo to be judged along with the \$10 entry fee. There will also be an optional "dollar a vote" people's choice contest. The contestant that raises the most money will receive the People's Choice trophy. There will be a table set up at the pageant for voting. These contests are OPTIONAL and results will not be used to determine the pageant winners.

During the pageant, Indemnitor hereby agrees with Miss Lake of the Ozarks Pageant, staff and volunteers as follows:

Indemnitor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless owners and aforementioned pageant and its and their agents and servants, from and against any and all claims, actions, damages, liability and expense in connection with loss of life, personal injury and/ or damage to property arising from or out of any occurrence in, upon or at the licensed area by Indemnitor and any other occupant or user of all or any part of licensed area, and its and their agents, servants, contractors, and employees, if any actions or proceeding is brought against Owner or Pageant listed or its or their agents to defend such actions or proceeding at its own expense by counsel satisfactory to owner.

The Miss Lake of the Ozarks Executive Board expects each Contestant to display the highest degree to sportsmanship during the Pageant and particularly following the Coronation. Poor sportsman-like conduct may affect future eligibility to compete in Miss Lake of the Ozarks pageants. No refunds will be given.
